Simone is the Co-Founder and CEO of **Digital Transformation Solutions (DTS)**, a deeptech company powering digital transformation in public agencies, and Co-Founder and Co-Director of the **Cambridge SupTech Lab** at the University of Cambridge. He brings 19 years of experience leading transformation across banking, telecoms, payments, and public-sector technology.

A repeat intrapreneur, Simone has designed and scaled innovative programmes inside multilateral institutions, development agencies, and academic centres—operating with the speed and creativity of a startup founder. He has led high-stakes engagements with the World Bank, United Nations, GSMA, IDLO, and BFA Global, delivering results for partners including the Bank for International Settlements (BIS), European Central Bank, New York State Department of Financial Services, Visa, Meta, World Economic Forum, Mastercard Foundation, UK FCDO, USAID, ADB, IDB, and dozens of central banks, fintechs, and ministries of finance.
